Practices

- 2 practices a week, earliest start times are 5:30, latest time to finish 9:00 for older teams
- Practice Days: Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays evenings or Sundays after church time

- Ringgold: Tiger Creek Elementary, Graysville Elementary, Ringgold United Methodist Church, Heritage High, Ringgold Middle, 1st Baptist of Chickamauga
- Dalton: Christian Heritage, Christ Church Presbyterian
- Chattanooga: Silverdale Cumberland Presbyterian

Because we have a wide range of players coming from the Chattanooga, Ringgold, Dalton, Chickamauga, Calhoun, and other areas we try to plan each team to practice once in Ringgold/Chattanooga and once in Dalton each week. We feel this is the most fair practice model. This cannot happen in every situation.

Tournaments

- Tournament season runs January- Beginning of May
- 1 Day tournaments: Typically begins at 8 AM and could run from 3:00-8:00, or later depending on how the day goes.
- 2 Day tournaments: Broken into AM and PM waves. AM waves are typically 8 AM-1 or 2 PM. PM waves begin around 3 PM.
- There are a good number of local tournaments in the Chattanooga and North Georgia Areas. We attend a
 few tournaments in the Atlanta, Nashville, and Knoxville areas. Most teams will participate in SRVA
 Regionals, Battleground Explosion at the Chattanooga Convention Center, and 1 overnight in Gatlinburg.
- 11U-12U teams are predominantly local 1 days. 12U may play 1-2 two day tournaments if coaches see fit.
- Remaining tournaments are based on the skill level of each team and schedules are created very soon after a team is formed so that we may cater the schedule to the skill level of the team.
- Option to extend season for Nationals will be discussed at the 1st team meeting.

Expectations

- Playing time is determined by ATTITUDE, EFFORT, COACHABILITY, skill level, volleyball knowledge, attendance, and team chemistry. Playing time is <u>earned</u> in practice.
- On average a team roster consists of 9-10 players, no more than 11
- Teams are formed based on the team needs. Players are kept with a certain role in mind.
- Multi Sport Athletes are welcome, but please note that timely communication is key
 - o Players will be asked to provide their practice & game schedules to their coaches
 - If the number of absences are too significant, playing time can be affected
- Our Culture is very important to us. No disrespect of coaches, players, officials will be tolerated.

What to have Prepared for Tryouts

The following should be completed online prior to arriving at Tryouts:

- 1) Registration Form through Anthem United website/Pay Tryout Fee of \$50
 - Tryout Fee increases to \$60 if you are not registered by the deadline (July 10th)
- 2) <u>USAV Medical Release Form</u> (linked on Tryout tab)
- 3) Pre-Register with SRVA for SRVA membership
 - Go to SRVA.org to register and for instructions. This opens on their site July 1st for new club athletes!
 If you had an SRVA membership last season with any club, it does not expire until Aug 31st and so you will be all set for Tryouts.

Please bring a physical copy of the following to tryouts:

- Physical SRVA Membership Card or digital copy on your phone
- Printed <u>USAV Medical Release Form</u> (not required to be notarized)

Age Definitions

**We ask that everyone try out with their correct age division. In order to have the most competitive teams, it is rare that we move players up but will if there is a position need/large skill gap.

USAV age is by definition, the age of the athlete on JULY 1st 2025.

Athletes are not allowed to "play down"

Players with young birthdates may tryout with their grade level.

Post Tryouts

- Emails will be sent with results. You will have 5 days after receiving an email to accept an invitation to join a team.
- PLEASE discuss as a family ahead of time, if you are offered a spot at AU what your decision would be. Receiving decisions back on day 1 allows us to form teams quickly and get results out to other families in a timely manner.
- We do prayerfully consider every decision and spend time looking at scores and tryout results. PLEASE tell your child not to panic if they do not receive an email right away, emails can take up to a week after Tryouts and Makeups conclude as we hear back from other athletes.
